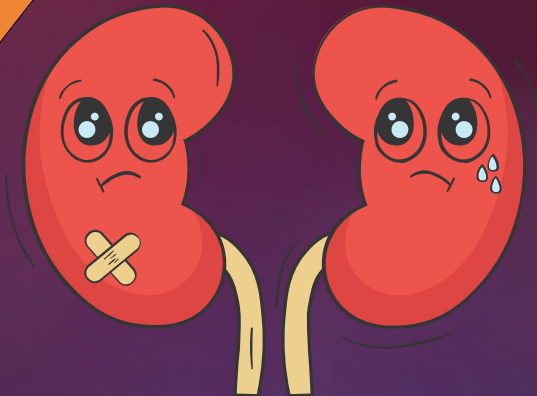
Meet Invited Speakers

The exhibition pavilion of the Republic of France was built in 1936/1937. year in Zagreb, as part of the Zagreb Choir fair, according to the project of the French construction engineer Bernard Lafaille, the structural designer.

The French pavilion represents a unique engineering innovation where for the first time a thin-walled wind-pierced structure was used for a load-bearing structure in a high-rise building, so we are talking about a building of exceptional cultural-historical and technical-technological value, which exceeds the boundaries of local significance.
