RATIONALE

So far in Croatia, in co-organization with ISSOP, four European schools of social pediatrics were held. Next, 5th School in 2016 will be dedicated to the topic Child friendly cities. Child in the City programmes represent very complex activities aiming to improve health of children in urban areas. Essentially they have strong impact on physical, mental and social health of children, so they should be a point of interest for professionals dealing with social and preventive pediatrics. In multidisciplinary approach we expect more active role of pediatricians in promotion, introduction, monitoring and evaluation of national Child in the City programmes. European Network of Child Friendly Cities specific model is based upon experiences of several best developed national programmes (France, Spain, Croatia).

Here are some information on EN CFC: "Child in the City" is an international community and platform with about 3000 interested members dealing with issues related to the wellbeing of children concerning city space for children, children's rights to play, children's health or in general children's wellbeing in cities and communities. The right for children to participate in decision-making processes during a city's design and planning is important part of CFC program. We will bring Child in a City academics and practitioners together with pediatricians to elaborate indivisibility of physical, mental, social and educational health of a child and consequent need for cooperation.
